### **Sunday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, Bell, Book and Candle:**

The Lakewood Theatre Company is performing the play *Bell, Book and Candle* by playwright John Van Druten. Before there was *Bewitched*, there was this stylish and funny romantic comedy about Gillian a smart, independent and beautiful woman who decides to amuse herself by casting a love spell on her handsome young neighbor and her life is turned upside down. Gillian deals with the hilarious consequences of her new situation with the supernatural assistance of her eccentric aunt and beatnik warlock brother. *Bell, Book and Candle* is an enchantingly funny romantic comedy that asks the questions, "How much are you willing to change for the one you love?" Join us for the afternoon matinee at the Lakewood Theatre. The play starts at 2:00pm and after the performance for those who would like, we will go to dinner somewhere near the theatre.

**Cost: \$25.00.** We will carpool to this event and dinner is on your own. **Reservations due by February 1<sup>st</sup>, after that time the tickets must be released back to the theatre.**

### **Saturday, March 28<sup>th</sup>, Mission Mill and lunch:**

We will tour the Thomas Kay Woolen Mill and the Jason Lee House at the Mission Mill Museum in Salem. This historic 5-acre site interprets the vibrant red structures of the mill and simple white houses of the devout Methodist missionaries, the founders of Salem. The Thomas Kay Woolen Mill, founded in 1889 by Thomas Lister Kay, was one of numerous woolen mills that operated throughout the valley and which were critical to its economic stability. Kay's descendants own and operate the world-renowned Pendleton Woolen Mills. The historic homes on the site are the Jason Lee House, the Parsonage, John D. Boon House and Pleasant Grove Church, dating from the 1840s and 1850s, are restored and furnished in the period. The Lee House and Parsonage are said to be the oldest remaining frame houses in the Pacific Northwest. Both were built as part of the Methodist mission to area American Indians. The Parsonage is said to have served as the Indian Manual Training School that eventually became Willamette University. Join us as we explore a little of Oregon History and the beginning of the Methodist Church in Oregon. After the tour, we will go to lunch at the Ram just minutes from Mission Mill. **Cost: \$12.00** includes admission, church bus transportation, driver and gratuity. Lunch will be on your own. **Time:** Meet at the church at 9:30am returning approximately 3:30pm. **Reservations due by March 15<sup>th</sup>.**
